Terms & Conditions

Please read and agree to the booking terms and conditions set out below before booking with us.

Our Contract

By buying the ticket with us, you are deemed to have agreed to these Mindroom Innovation Camping Conditions (which constitute the entire agreement between you and us), and your booking will be accepted by us on this basis. The services to be provided are those referred to in your sign-up form and in this document.

Validity

This trip/ticket is non-refundable, but you can transfer it to someone if this is organised by yourself. In addition, you will need to advise us that you have transferred your booking to another person, and this person will need to complete the MI Spring Camp Form. This must be done by email, finance@mindroom.edu.au, using the email you have booked your spot with.

Cost

You are required to pay for the trip by 20th September 2023 or as directed by our finance team. The price is \$75. Once you have paid, this will guarantee your spot on this trip. This cost will cover the following: campsite, two breakfasts, one dinner, drinking water and group sports activities. It does not cover extra costs such as your own drinks (alcohol, soft drink or juice), snacks or any of the meals not included.

Acceptance Of This Trip

Once your payment has been made, you understand this forms a contract between Mindroom Innovation and yourself. You are responsible for being aware of the terms and conditions outlined within.

Your Details

The necessary details include your full name as per your passport, telephone number, any pre-existing medical conditions you have that may affect your ability to complete your travel arrangements and payment confirmation.. Your booking cannot be confirmed without the provision of these details.

Cancellation by the traveller

If you fail to join a tour, no refund will be made.

Inclusions

The following items are included in the price of the trip:

- 2 nights camping fee
- 3 meals (2 Breakfasts, 1 dinner)
- Group sport activities (Soccer, Beach volleyball, Frisbee..)
- The services of a group leader
- Guidance during the camping
- 3 Mindroom staff helping
- The organisation of the trip.

Exclusions

The price of your trip does not include:

- International or internal flights;
- A tent – You must bring your own tent;
- Personal items;
- Extra meals or extra drinks;
- Ice and cooler to keep your food/drinks;
- Travel Insurance;
- Or any other optional activities, expenditures or personal expenses.

This trip was only able to be organised and performed as the MI Staff are working as volunteers, they will not get paid therefore we ask you to respect and help them out.

What to Bring

- Sleeping bag (or blankets and sheets) and pillow with pillowcases.
- Comfortable, enclosed shoes with grip.

Comfortable pants / long shorts - room to move & be agile.

Sufficient clothes for camp - underwear, socks, pyjamas, t-shirts, jeans, jumper/jacket etc

Hat & Sunscreen

Personal toiletries - toothpaste, brush, shampoo, conditioner, shower gel/soap, deodorant etc

Hair ties & clips - Long hair must be tied back for climbing activities.

Shower Towel

Personal insect repellent

Swimmers (+ rashi recommended) & Beach Towel

Water bottle

Torch with batteries

Bags for wet towels, swimmers or clothes.

We do not provide WiFi, so bring your own mobile broadband USB.

We recommend valuables be locked in your car or left at home.

Age & Health Requirements

The minimum age at the time of travel applies, which is 18 years or above unless an adult accompanies the under-aged. We do not have an upper age limit, though we remind you that our trips can be physically demanding, and you must ensure you are suitably fit to allow full participation.

Insurance

Travel insurance or OSHC is mandatory for all our travellers (international students) and should be taken at the time of booking.

Arrival Time

On Friday, no earlier than 2 pm.

Departure Time

On Sunday, no later than 2 pm.

Authority on Tour

Our group trips are run by a group leader and the Mindroom Staff (Pedro, Daniela and Vanessa). The group leader's decision is final on all matters likely to affect the safety or well-being of any person participating in the trip. If you fail to comply with a decision made by a group leader or interfere with the well-being or mobility of the group, the group leader may direct you to leave the trip immediately, with no right of refund. We may also elect not to carry you on any future trips booked.

Acceptance of Risk

You acknowledge that the nature of the trip is adventurous, and participation involves a degree of personal risk. You will be visiting places where the political, cultural and geographical attributes present dangers and physical challenges greater than those present in our daily lives. It is also your own responsibility to acquaint yourself with all possible relevant travel information and the nature of your itinerary. You acknowledge that your decision to travel is made considering this information, and you accept that you are aware of the personal risks attendant upon such travel.

Optional Activities

Optional activities not included in the trip price do not form part of the trip or this contract. You accept that any assistance your group leader or local representative gives in arranging optional activities does not render us liable for them in any way. The contract for the provision of that activity will be between you and the activity provider.

Photos & Marketing

You provide your consent to us to use images of you taken during the trip for advertising and promotional purposes in any medium we choose. You grant us a perpetual, royalty-free, worldwide, irrevocable licence to use such images for publicity and promotional purposes.
